Administrator of the Year

- Leads and manages an efficient and effective structure for netball within the Netball Centre
- Spends time ensuring the structure works through communication and support
- Attends the relevant meetings to ensure the Netball Centre is kept well informed
- Looks for opportunities for administrators, players, coaches and umpires to develop
- Delegates to others and is on the look out for new faces
- Has shown some initiative or been innovative

Coaching Coordinator of the Year

- Encourages coaches to become coaches
- Works closely with all coaches in the Netball Centre
- Has planned and organized successful coaching courses
- Has an excellent communication structure for attracting and retaining coaches
- Has shown some initiative or been innovative

Umpire Coordinator of the Year

- Encourages people to become Umpires
- Works closely with all Umpires in the Netball Centre
- Provides opportunities for all who want to learn the rules to do so (theory & practical)
- Has a strong support structure in place for umpires
- Has shown some initiative or been innovative

Netball Centre ~ Umpire Development Programme of the Year

- Developed a new programme that has benefited the development of Umpires
- Developed a programme that trains and retains umpires
- Umpiring numbers have increased
- Greater numbers of qualified umpires available
- Seen as inspiring and encouraging umpire development for the Netball Centre

Netball Centre ~ Coaching Development Programme of the Year

- Ran or organized a number of coaching courses and programmes
- Attracted people to take up coaching
- Structures in place for attracting and retaining coaches
- Seen as inspiring and encouraging coach development

Netball Centre ~ Innovative Competition of the Year

- Created an innovative competition to meet the needs of the community
- The competition added to the current Netball Centre Competition Programme
- The competition has attracted more players and or increased team numbers
- The plan is to extend or grow the competition beyond where it is now

Club of the Year

- A vibrant club that looks after its players, coaches, umpires and administrators
- A club that provides development opportunities and encourages its personnel to be part of them

- A club that attracts new members to all areas of the game
- A club that assists and supports the Netball Centre it belongs to

Centre Umpire of the Year

- Has qualified as a Netball Centre Umpire
- Has umpired regularly at the Netball Centre level
- Has willingly umpired for the Netball Centre at events either within or outside the Centre or Region
- Has willingly mentored aspiring Centre Umpires

Regional Umpire of the Year

- Has achieved their Regional Qualification
- Has umpired on a regular basis at Netball Centre, Baywide and other events for the Region
- An umpire who has umpired consistently throughout the season
- Has willingly mentored aspiring Regional and Centre Umpires

Umpire of the Year

- Has umpired on a regular basis at the Netball Centre, Baywide, and other events beyond the Region
- An umpire who is consistently mentioned by players as being fair and consistent
- An umpire who has achieved recognition at the NNZ level
- An umpire who has achieved the highest possible qualification and or is an outstanding umpire.

Fun Ferns/Future Ferns Coach of the Year

- Has made an outstanding contribution to a school and or within the Centre working on development opportunities/programmes and days
- Has coached a team that has seen the players learn skills and develop a game sense
- Has attended coaching courses or programmes

Intermediate School Coach of the Year

- Has made an outstanding contribution to a school within the Centre working on development opportunities/programmes and days
- Has coached a successful team
- Has attended coaching courses or programmes
- Achieved results at the highest possible level with a school team

Club Coach of the Year

- Has made an outstanding contribution to a club within the Centre working on development opportunities/programmes and days
- Has coached a successful club team
- Has worked on attaining coaching accreditation.
- Achieved results at the highest possible level with a club team

Representative Coach of the Year

- Has made an outstanding contribution to the Centre and or the Region working on development opportunities/programmes and days.
- Has coached a winning representative team
- Has contributed to the successful development of individual play etc
- Has worked on attaining coaching accreditation.
- Achieved results at the highest possible level with a club, Centre and or Regional team.

Club Player of the Year

- A player who has worked hard to improve their playing capability
- An outstanding player who has represented the Region (past or present)
- A player who may have been identified by NNZ
- Has a sense of Fair Play
- Made a contribution to the life of the Region

Netballer of the Year

- An outstanding player who has played for the Bay of Plenty Age Group, Scottwood Trust Championships and/or Magic Teams
- A player who has worked hard to improve their playing capability
- A player who may have been identified by NNZ
- Has a sense of Fair Play
- Made a contribution to the life of the Region

Volunteer of the Year

- Has made a substantial contribution to the Life of the Netball Centre and the Region
- Has consistently and willingly given their time and energy to programmes, activities, or events run by the Netball Centre and or the Region

Long Serving and Outstanding Volunteers

- Has given 10 years service or more
- Held offices or made a substantial contribution within the Netball Centre
- Has made a significant contribution to the Life of the Netball Centre and the Region

- Has increased membership numbers
- Has been innovative in its netball umpiring and coaching programmes and created innovative competitions to meet the needs of its community
- Has created a positive profile for netball within its community
- Has planned for success – coaching, umpiring, playing and other activities
